



Staff specialist in Radiology in Central-Norway

Two vacancies as a staff specialist/consultant in radiology at the department of medical imaging is open in public hospitals in Central-Norway.

Hospital 1:

The candidate will work at the medical imaging department. The department has nine consultant positions, and three junior doctor positions. Approx. 85 000 examinations are performed each year. The department is fully digitalized, and has 10 laboratories including nuclear medicine. The equipment includes:

- CT: 32-kanal Toshiba MDCT with Vitrea workstation.
- MR: GE 1,5 T, upgraded with Cube and cardiac package. Gynecological and rectum examinations are also made.
- UL: 4 ultrasonic app., incl. 2 brand new Toshiba devices, one with Fusion imaging and Elastography.
- Mammography: Siemens Mammomat, digital app.
- RIS/PACS: SECTRA, common for all imaging departments in Norway.

Hospital 2:

The department of Medical Imaging has five consultant posts and two training positions. 36,000 examinations are conducted each year, of which approx. 5,300 are CT and 5,000 MR. The equipment is modern, and involves Philips Ingenia 1,5 T MR, Toshiba Aquilion 32 CT, Toshiba Aplio 500, ultrasound, and more.

The department is fully digitalized and uses digital dictation with speech recognition, and has good arrangements for professional development, course participation and education. The departments participate in the national mammography program.

The candidate will be expected to:

- Participate in the department's ordinary radiology related work, including guard duties
- Have good communication skills
- Be cooperative
- Have experience in basic interventional procedures

Great emphasis will be put on personal qualities, efficiency and professional ambitions

We offer:

- Permanent contract after six months.
- Training courses within working hours.
