



Staff specialist in Children and Adolescent Psychiatry in South-Norway

A vacancy as a staff specialist/consultant in psychiatry at the children and adolescents psychiatry section for immediate help (BUPA) is open in a public hospital in South-Norway.

The section has approx. 350 fulltime positions, and is organized as its own department within the clinic of mental health.

BUPA consists of 10 sections: 5 outpatient clinics, section for immediate help, neuropsychiatric section, intermediate unit for adolescents, long-term unit for adolescents and an ambulant family section. The catchment area for the department is approx. 108 000 children in 26 municipalities. There is an active and solid medical environment in the department with a total of 30 consultant positions, and there is regular medical specific teaching and medical meetings for all doctors in the department. Professional project development and clinical research is stimulated and the clinic has its own research & development unit.

The candidate will be placed at the section for immediate help.

Responsibilities:

- Evaluation and treatment of children and adolescents with mental disorders in accordance with applicable laws and guidelines
- Immediate help: reception, assessment and treatment
- Suicide problems, acute psychosis, severe eating disorders
- Actively participate in teaching and guidance of junior doctors

Requirements:

- Have a good ability to assess complex and complicated conditions states
- Have experience with assessing and managing suicide/violence risk
- Have knowledge and interest in the treatment of complex trauma/relational injuries
- Relevant experience from the field of children and adolescent psychiatry

There are guard duties to the position.

We offer:

- Permanent contract after six months.
- Training courses within working hours.
- Help to find: apartment, school and kindergarten.
- Study tour to Norway after a first interview, to learn more about the region and the work environment.
- Assistance with removal and relocation costs.
- Intensive Norwegian course, also for partner.
- A scholarship for the Norwegian course of 700 EUR monthly net, a supplement for children of 70 EUR monthly net, free apartment and travel costs for the family.

Requirements:

- Specialist exam in children and adolescent psychiatry.
- Experience as a children and adolescent psychiatrist.
- Ability to complete the Norwegian intensive course.
